## Box Making and All the Options

- Function = simple, pencil, storage, treasure, artistic, jewelry
- Small parts = more safety, sacrificial parts, use hold-downs, push sticks, jigs to hold parts for repetition
- "Design is a key aspect of box making" (often the hardest part)
- Get inspired by anything and everything
- Most importantly: have fun
